Summer on the Cuyahoga (SOTC) is NEO's premier summer internship program. We work with organizations like yours and eleven partner universities with active alumni networks in NEO to bring great talent to the region! Undergraduates and recent graduates from Allegheny, U of Chicago, Colgate, Cornell, Cleveland State, CWRU, Denison, Miami U, Oberlin, Ohio Wesleyan, and Smith participate each summer.



### CHALLENGING PAID INTERNSHIPS:

Employers can recruit interns to work on teams and projects in a plethora of fields such as finance, marketing, art history, engineering, non-profit, community development, software development, etc. Whatever your needs, SOTC will help you find qualified candidates to meet them.



### **COMMUNITY EVENTS:**

SOTC hosts more than 40 events for interns that include cultural & social happenings, discussion with business leaders, career exploration panels, community, and alumni gatherings. Employers are welcomed and encouraged to join a variety of events each summer.

## 3 ALUMNI HOSTS:

Each intern is paired with a local alumni host to help them adjust to Northeast Ohio. Hosts serve as additional connections to the community, providing crucial professional introductions. It's also encouraged that they attend some of our events such as our opening/closing receptions and annual mixer.



### **GROUP HOUSING:**

Housing is arranged by SOTC and provided at NO ADDITIONAL COST to students. Participants live as a cohort in an apartment-like dormitory on CWRU's campus, allowing employers to hire the best candidates without worrying about finding housing and inability to get to work.

### **EMPLOYER INFORMATION**

- The portal will go live for employer postings no later than September. We recommend employers post internship positions by early February.
- There is NO FEE for posting or obligations to hire an intern if an employer doesn't find a student that meets preferred criteria.
- The deadline for hiring is MAY 23rd. We encourage employers to hire interns by March to have access to a larger talent pool and avoid interview scheduling conflicts caused by spring break.
- The SOTC employer fee remains at \$1,100/intern. This fee will be invoiced to help cover the cost of housing and events for each intern.
- The minimum wage for SOTC interns is \$10/hr, though the average wage is \$14/hr.
- SOTC internships are 8, 9, or 10 weeks (the official program typically runs 9 weeks from June to August).
- Employers are invited to our Employer Orientation Luncheon in May, Opening & Closing receptions, and Collegiate Career & Community Leader Mixer.

### POSTING AN INTERNSHIP WITH SOTC

**Dual Application Process?** Employers may add a dual application link in their posting. There is an 'additional comments' box where this can be listed.

- 1. Go to www.summeronthecuyahoga.com
- 2. Select the **EMPLOYERS tab** at the top then scroll down and click the EMPLOYER REGISTRATION AND LOGIN BUTTON. If this is your first time using the portal, complete the information under REGISTER FOR A NEW ACCOUNT and submit by clicking the REGISTER button.
- 3. Select **ADD INTERNSHIP POSTING** or you may modify and/or re-post a previous position already in your account.
- 4. Complete the position information.
  - a. Please note: We recommend that you create a Word document with the position information and then copy and paste this info into the SOTC website. This way, if something happens you will not have to retype the entire job description. The SOTC website times-out when idle, so please load your internship description in one sitting.
  - b. We recommend you select car required if it is inconvenient to take RTA or to walk from CWRU to your work site. Please also provide more information about it in the description.
  - c. Once happy with the job description, check boxes to agree to SOTC's terms.
- 5. Select SAVE INTERNSHIP. Please note that SOTC will approve your posting before it goes live on the student site.

#### 6. **Review applications:**

- a. Login using your employer login.
- b. Select VIEW CANDIDATES.
  - Select PROFILE and/or RESUME to review the application.
  - For each applicant, please update their status by selecting IN REVIEW, DECLINE or OFFER.

If IN REVIEW is selected, candidates status will change to 'In Review' on their account. If DECLINE is selected. candidates will automatically receive a declined email. If OFFER is selected, you will be able to create an offer email that is sent to SOTC and then forwarded to the candidate.

- 7. Review all applications and select students for interviews. The timing of this process may extend into spring and depends on each employer. We request offers be given by May 23rd.
- 8. Please contact Eric McGarvey at emcgarvey@summeronthecuyahoga.com once you are ready to make an offer.
- 9. To remove your posting from the SOTC website:
  - a. Login using your employer login and select EDIT next to the posting you wish to close.
  - b. Select all boxes, including "Check here if you would like to close this job and stop receiving further applications."
  - c. Click UPDATE INTERNSHIP.
